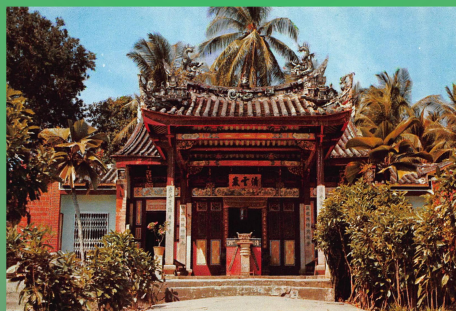

## DAY 2

Good morning! Breakfast at hotel. Let's discover the natural beauty of Penang Island and explore its awe-inspiring sights. First place for today's tour begin with Penang Batik Factory in Teluk Bahang where we are going to witness the local traditional art of fabric process from waxing, painting and dyeing. Drive through the hills and enjoy beautiful scenery with lush greenery of a tropical rainforest dotted with fruit orchards and spices. Slide off the road and stop at nearby street stall. We are going to see and taste the varieties of fruits and spices produce by local farmers. Next, continue drive to a valley that clusters the Malay Traditional houses with the views of paddy fields. Our tour continues by visiting the Centuries-Old Snake Temple. Stop at Coffee Tree and buy some Penang local products back home as souvenirs. Return to hotel and rest for the night.



## DAY 3



Get ourselves ready and have breakfast at hotel. We shall drive down to Air Hitam. We are going to visit the largest Buddhist temple in Southeast Asia, the Kek Lok Si Temple, (also known as the "Temple of Supreme Bliss"). Enjoy a breathtaking sight of the Gigantic Goddess Of Mercy Bronze Statue overlooking the entire temple precinct and its vicinity, then take a stroll up the seven-storey Pagoda which houses over 10,000 Buddha statues. From the temple, head to the highest peak of Penang, Penang Hill, the must-visit destination on our checklist. The funicular train was used as a retreat during the British colonial period, enjoy our uphill ride. Be amazed of the magnificent panorama view of George Town and the Penang mainland. While you're at it, try spotting the two Penang Bridges! Stop at Gurney Drive for dinner and enjoy famous Penang delicacies such as Laksa Penang, Pasembor and many more!



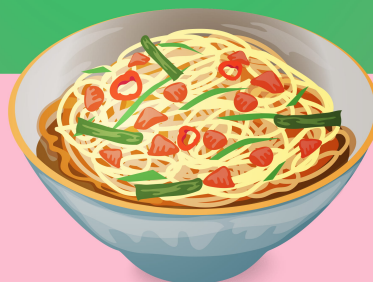
## DAY 4

Morning! breakfast at hotel before tour continues. Tour starts at Georgetown city. Hop on a Trishaw. Trishaw was a popular and the only mode of transportation in Penang in the olden days. We will ride trishaw at the first checkpoint - Fort Cornwallis where was built in 1786. Along the ride in the town, we shall witness Queen Victoria Memorial Clock Tower and Waterfront Jetties. Continue riding through the colourful Little India, St. George's Church, old Chinese Temples, heritage boutique hotels and cafes. The ride will end at The Blue Mansion, an iconic pieces of architecture.
